SPECIAL SESSION MEETING NO. 13, MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL, MAY 1, 1974

This Special Session of the Mayor and City Council was called to order by President Powell at 1:00 P.M., in the Mayor's office, City Hall, 3rd and Baltimore Avenue, Ocean City, Maryland.

President Powell stated the purpose of the meeting was to discuss and pass on the parking regulations and occupancy of the Ramada Inn. At this point motion made Councilman Cropper that the Council instruct Mr. William Hoover, Zoning Administrator and Mr. Brady Bounds, Building Inspector, to give notice to the Ramada Inn their parking shall have to be in one hundred percent compliance by Monday, May 6, 9:00 A.M. If it is not it will be enforced by a "no occupancy" by the Mayor and City Council. This motion seconded by Councilman Frame; vote by show of hands; unanimous vote by all in attendance (note Councilman Purnell in absentia).

Mayor Kelley stated, "I think Mr. President it might well be on our minutes that Ramada Inn will be so instructed as of today, Wednesday, May 1st that this procedure will take place."

Mr. Frame questioned, "In other words Brady and Bill are going up this afternoon and inform them?" President Powell advised him yes and this would be followed up by official letters containing the above information.

With no other business the meeting was adjourned at 1:15 P.M.
